

## Discounted Rates for Activities by Region in Auckland

### **Central Auckland**

[Aotea Centre](#) offers free parking for a person with a disability card, need to go up and show the people at entrance of carpark

[Archery War](#) – 20% off total session price

[Auckland Adventure Jets](#) - \$78 for adult and \$58 child

[Auckland Adventure duck](#) – Adult - \$48 and child \$38

[Auckland Art Gallery](#) – Free entry for everyone

Auckland Blues Rugby Matches – Disabled person and companion can free tickets to game matches

[Auckland Jet Boat Tours](#) – Booking for 4 people – 5%, bookings for 6 people – 7.5%, bookings for 12 – 10% discount

[Auckland Museum](#) is free for Auckland residents (you don't have to pay the donation except if visiting special events) – need proof of living in Auckland though

[Auckland Zoo](#) – Caregivers are free and normal cost for a person with a disability.

[Cameron Pool and Leisure Mt Roskill](#) - \$2.70 per person and caregiver is free. Children under 16 free

[Chipmunks Mt Roskill](#) \$6 per person under 11yo (please state special needs rate)

[Escape Masters](#) – Would like to offer 50% discount for a person with a disability who come to play

[Event Cinema – St Lukes](#) – \$16.50 per session for a person with a community services card

[Fullers ferry](#) – free adult child per disabled child

[Kelly Tarltons](#) – free for carer & pay for disabled person just need to mention (sometimes they ask questions and may question it)

[Hoyts](#) – \$12 each ticket to general admission. Does not include no free list, hoyts lux, extreme screen, 3d or D-box cinema

[Lido Theatre](#) – \$8.50 during weekday or Tuesday after 8pm for a person with a Community Service Card – no discount other evenings or weekends.

[Lilliput Mini Golf](#) – Tamaki Drive, Sylvia Park, New Lynn \$10 per person

[Maritime Museum](#) - is free for Auckland residents

[Motat](#) – Free for carer and disabled person

[Mt Albert Aquatic Centre](#) - all people with a disability including children - \$3.30 caregiver is free.

[Odyssey Sensory Maze](#) –wheelchairs cannot complete all the maze. 5-12yo - \$13, Students w ID - \$15 and Adults \$17. Wheelchairs users will not be able to complete all the maze. You will need to ring them prior (people with epilepsy / claustrophobic they do not recommend visiting)

[Olympic Pools Newmarket](#) – For a person with a disability \$3 and caregiver is free.

[Onehunga War Memorial Pool](#) – If requiring caregiver in pool then \$4.50 and disabled person is free. In person in pool doesn't need caregiver it is \$4.50. Children under 16 free

[Paradise Ice Skating](#) – Botany/Avondale - \$8 per person

[Tepid Baths](#) – Community Services card rates \$6. Children under 16 free. Caregiver is free. Please inform if you are the caregiver/have a disability

[Westlynn Butterfly Park](#) – \$3 per person (no discount) and under 2 is free

## **South Auckland / Counties**

[Butterfly Creek](#) – Special needs under 3 – Free carer to one child , 3-15 years \$9.60 - 1 carer to one paying person is free, 16+ \$16.20 - 1 carer to one paying person is free. Train ride \$3 per person 1:1 carer is free. During Monday-Friday only. School holidays and weekends are full price.

[Chipmunks Manukau](#) – all special needs up to age 11yo - free and caregiver free

[Event Cinema Manukau](#) – \$16 per person with a disability - caregivers normal price. On Tuesdays only \$12.50 including caregiver

[Franklin Leisure Pools](#) – \$2.50 per person and caregiver is free. Children under 16 free

[Highfield Park and Donkeys](#) – free for all

[Hoyts](#) – \$12 each ticket to general admission. Does not include no free list, hoyts lux, extreme screen, 3d or D-box cinema

[Jump](#) – \$16 per person (BYO Jump socks) Caregiver can jump for free

[Manurewa Pools](#) - \$2.10 per person with a community services card, caregiver is \$3.30. Children under 16 free

[Massey Park Pools](#) Papakura – \$3.20 for person with disability, caregiver is \$3.20. Children under 16 free

[Moana Nui a Kiwi Pool Mangere](#) – all free

[Miranda Hot Pools](#) – Children 3-13yo \$7 (normal price) and \$9 for adults with a disability

[Papatoetoe Pools](#) – all free

[Pukekohe Ten Pin Bowling](#) - \$5 per person including caregiver and must book prior

[Rainbows End](#) – 50% and it has to be 1:1

[Rocket Ropes](#) – Free supervisor/caregiver for children up to age 16

[Spookers](#) – They offer a discount for a minimum of 10 people and is an overall discount but must ring and enquire and book first

[Treasure Island Mini Golf](#) – Airport - \$5 person for first game and additional \$2.50 for second game.

[Wrights Watergardens](#) – This wonderful place is located Patumahoe. This organisation are offering a wonderful new service with wheelchair access to bottom and top of waterfall (you will be driven down to this by staff, but will need to phone in advance. They also have a new chef from 180 Degrees Restaurant in Wellington and they also run a business Amphora Restaurant in Botany. We will offer 50% off Garden Entries. Free muffin or scone for any coffee brought. 20% group discount on any food items purchased. In order to provide this we require a booking in advance 12-24 hours.

## **East Auckland**

Children under 16 free

[Howick Historical Village](#) – Person with a disability \$8 and caregivers free [Hoyts](#) – \$12 each ticket to general admission.

Does not include no free list, hoyts lux, extreme screen, 3d or D-box cinema

[Lagoon Pool and Leisure Centre Panmure](#) – \$3 per person with a disability. If caregiver swimming \$3 if caregiver out of water is free - Children under 16 free

[Lloyd Elsmore Park Pool and Leisure](#) - \$3 per person with a disability. \$1 caregiver if needs to be in water - caregiver - free if out of water. Children under 16 free

## **West Auckland**

[BFF Adventureland and Café](#) – Don't give specific disability discount but will offer 20% discount to various associations connected to children. You will need to say that you received this information via Disability Connect to receive this discount.

[Blastacars](#) - We had a paraplegic kart which we are now unable to use due to needing certification however if you think this person can understand a simple safety video then the best day to bring them in would be a Tuesday(quiet period)We would start them on our kids speed first and this will cost \$20 for 15 minutes.

[Chipmunks Henderson](#) – Will offer a free coffee to the supervising person of any child presenting a disability card (weekdays only)

[Crystal Mountain](#) – has some discount but also seems to vary (best to check first)

[Exploratorium](#) - 10 people or more during week 20% discount

[Event Cinema – Westcity](#) – \$8.50 per adult. All members of NZ Deaf or Blind Associations will receive a free ticket on Monday's to any standard screen presentation of their association membership. This offer excludes 3d, premium offerings such as Vmax or Gold Class and alternative content including Bollywood or Cinema Asia titles.

[Event Cinema – Westgate](#) – \$15 per person with disability. \$15 per caregiver. Tuesday is \$12

[Extreme Edge West](#) - \$10 per person to both disabled people and caregivers. All day pass so they can come and go as please, this includes hire of harness and introductory safety briefing.

[Chipmunks Albany](#) – please contact prior as will offer discount

[Event Cinema Albany](#) – \$12.50 per person with a disability and their caregiver.

[Horse Riding Warkworth](#) – can offer \$5 discount per person, normal price is \$50 per person. You need to book first.

[Inflatable World Glenfield](#) - caregivers only free

[Fullers ferry](#) – free adult child per disabled child

[Glenfield Pools](#) - \$5 per person \$5 per caregiver. Children under 16 free

[Jump](#) – \$16 per person (BYO Jump socks) Caregiver can jump for free
