What happens at the hui?

The hui are social meet-ups facilitated by Autistic people. No more than 13 people attend each hui, meaning everyone has a chance to participate in a meaningful way. You are welcome to participate in whatever way works for you: turn your camera on or keep it off; speak up, comment in the chat or just listen.

Please note that this is a social connections group, not a mental health group.

Who can attend?

These hui are for anyone who is Autistic or thinks they might be Autistic - you do not need a formal autism diagnosis to attend.

We have one group for 18-25 year olds and two groups for 26+ year olds.

When are the hui?

The **18-25yo** group meets fortnightly on **Fridays, 8-9pm**.

One group for **26yo+** meets weekly on **Fridays, 1-2pm**.

The other group for **26yo+** meets fortnightly on **Saturdays, 8-9pm**
