

Easy Beats – Learn how to make music using our easy-to-use music creation tools.

This will be delivered at an introductory/beginners level initially, with three sessions (12-2pm/3-5pm/6-8pm) each Wednesday. Our daytime session (12-2pm) will be entry level and all about getting hands-on with the gear, exploring how to create interesting sounds. Our afternoon session (3-5pm) will have greater learning focus, supporting people to create their own compositions. Our evening session (6-8pm) will be open to both disabled and non-disabled people, with a deeper focus on the fundamentals of beat-making, including practical and theoretical learning.

YouTuber Studio – This programme* will cover the basics of how to make great YouTube content, including everything from filming and editing techniques, developing subject matter, online safety, creating logos, thumbnails and theme music, understanding the YouTube tools and more. *Note that YouTuber Studio will run at 3-5pm each Wednesday to start with, with other sessions offered based on interest.

Both Easy Beats and YouTuber Studio will be 10 week programmes, and will kick-off from Wednesday 26 May. There will be limited spaces for each session, to ensure individual learning outcomes.

Easy Beats will be based at 312 Creative Hub at 1 Paynes Lane, Onehunga (in between Dressmart and Onehunga Mall Road)

YouTuber Studio will be primarily based at Spectrum Mahi at 310 Onehunga Mall Road, Onehunga (corner of Grey Street and Onehunga Mall Road)
