KOE MOKAI AKO (KMA)

Intensive Literacy and Numeracy support for youth 16+

We believe everyone, no matter their past, can learn to learn.


When you know that you can learn, your confidence increases because everything becomes possible. Good levels of Literacy and Numeracy are essential to living a good life; however not everyone has had the opportunity to learn effectively, in the way they needed, and in a way that values them as a person, until now.

QES is proud to offer an intensive literacy and numeracy programme, KOE MOKAI AKO which means the humble learner. Our programme is based on the Maori and Pacific holistic health models Te Whare Tapa Wha and FonoFale. It focuses on equipping our young people with the foundational literacy and numeracy skills of Reading, Writing, Maths and Speaking.

The stigma of having low levels of literacy and numeracy is a learning barrier for most people. This can affect their self-confidence or motivation to participate or move forward in their life. Learners are assessed on their literacy and numeracy ability when they enrol before an individual learning plan is developed to meet their learning needs and goals.

Our programme not only equips our Rangatahi with the foundation literacy skills to progress into future NZQA qualification programmes, but more importantly develops our young people holistically, making them better citizens of Aotearoa.

We specialise in transitioning our Koe Mokai Ako graduates into further education and training programmes.

Life's complicated! Everybody needs a hand sometimes.

QES Youth Services help our young people figure out the hard stuff so they can focus on what's important: themselves, their whanau and their future.

The Mana and wellbeing of our Rangatahi are at the centre of everything we do. We step in early to help Rangatahi build their confidence and increase their potential.

Our youth coaches are the heart of our Youth Service and they work with three target groups. Our Youth Service is available in Wiri, Manukau, Otahuhu and Papatoetoe.

NOT IN EDUCATION, EMPLOYMENT OR TRAINING (NEET)

NEET is our service for young people, aged 16 or 17, who aren't in employment, education or training. We support Rangatahi to stay in school or get back into education if they've left.

Your youth coach will help you find your path to the life you want. You'll talk to them about where you want to be and decide what training you need to get there.

They can help you get on the best course for you or tell you about ways you can get training while you work. They can also help with things that make it easier for you to focus on studying, like getting a driver's licence.

- Gain NCEA Level 2 or higher

YOUNG PARENT PAYMENT

If you're aged 16 - 19 and you have tamariki in your care, you might be able to get a Young Parent Payment towards your living costs. Bringing up a child is an important job, but you matter too! When your baby is old enough, your coach will help you get back into education, training, or work-based learning.

YOUTH PAYMENT

If you're 16 or 17 and you can't live at home, and your parents can't support you financially, you may be able to get a youth payment towards your living costs. The Youth Payment gives you the space to focus on your dreams and ambitions. While you're getting it, you'll work with a QES youth coach to get the education and skills you need to build a bright, independent future.

- 16 or 17 years of age
- We will help prepare you for work
- · You will learn how to prepare a budget
- · You'll develop new life skills
- We'll create a plan together to help you achieve your goals



ONE-TO-ONE MENTORING

Our focus is on supporting our Rangatahi into education, training and work-based learning, but we do much more. Our youth coaches provide intensive, tailored support to identify their goals and find the best path to reach them. Each youth coach works with around 20 Rangatahi. This gives them the time to get to know the Rangatahi and their Whanau; to understand their unique qualities, strengths and goals, and to tailor realistic plans that move them towards independence.

Youth Coaches support their young people in the ways they most need it - whether that means giving practical help with housing issues, preparing for job interviews or connecting our Rangatahi with their local support group.

Group work and fun activities, workshops and trips complement one-on-one mentoring.

YOUR YOUTH COACH HAS YOUR BACK

Whatever's going on in your life, your youth coach will be on your side. If you need to talk, your coach will listen. If your goals change, your coach can help you come up with a new plan. If something is holding you back, your coach can help you figure it out.

You can be in touch with your coach as much as you need to, but you'll speak to them at least once a month and meet at least every 90 days.

TUPU AOTEAROA FOR PASIFIKA YOUTH 15 YEARS+

Our communities flourish when Pacific People have access to work or learning opportunities. We want to ensure Pacific people have the right tools, education, training and opportunities to succeed.

Tupu Aotearoa supports Pasifika Youth 15 years and older to access work or learning opportunities on their journey to employment, further training or study.

Our programme helps Pasifika youth with:

- Identifying appropriate upskilling and training courses
- Career advice and guidance
- Job search
- Support with writing your CV and cover letter
- · Preparing for interviews
- Obtaining a driver's licence
- Pastoral care and support post-placement



EMPLOYMENT PREPARATION AND PLACEMENT FOR ALL YOUTH 18 YEARS+

QES has helped hundreds of people into employment to achieve their employment goals. Our Employment Preparation and Placement programme (EPP) supports eligible Work and Income clients with industry training and licences.

Clients must be referred from Work and Income offices in Manukau, Otahuhu, Papatoetoe and Papakura. We specialise in placing our clients in employment and continue to support them in their work for up to 12 months. People who complete this programme will:

- Be equipped with employment skills
- Build confidence in a fun, supportive environment
- Gain free industry-specific licences
- Have an updated CV and Cover Letter tailored to their chosen industry
- Be prepared for job interviews and have access to work attire from our partners at Dress for Success and Fix Up Look Sharp
- Be placed into employment


