Caring for a child or young adult living with a physical disability can be challenging, rewarding and at times difficult to cope with so our aim is to provide a little bit of magic when we can.

The Wilson Home Trust provides grants to families when they have exhausted all other avenues to obtain funding. Over the last three years we have provided over \$1.2m in grants, to over 700 families. The magic is when we see a child being able to join their family on outings thanks to a grant for a beach buggy or a trike, or when we provide a grant for the latest iPhone to a young adult and they become a DJ!



We aim to keep our administration costs as low as possible, so to assist us to reach families across the whole region we cover (from the top of the North Island to Gisborne), we are privileged to be represented by our partner Parent to Parent who are very active across the whole country. On the home front in Takapuna, the families and staff are really enjoying the two newly renovated Villas which are used by Health New Zealand for respite and rehabilitation. This includes the new playroom and a nurses station. 
